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West Tennessee Construction January 31, 2018 – February 7, 2018

District 47 - West TN - Northern

BENTON COUNTY, I-40 Truck Climbing Lane: Motorists should watch for trucks entering and exiting the roadway in a construction zone. *Speed limit is reduced to **60 MPH**.

Saturday, February 3, 5:00 a. m. through Sunday, February 4, 6:00 p. m.: There will be outside lane closures on I-40 westbound around MM 133.0 to remove concrete barrier rail. THP will assist with traffic control.

CARROLL COUNTY, SR 104: The grading, drainage, paving and construction of a bridge on SR 104 over Mill Creek. Roadway is **CLOSED** for duration of project.

CARROLL COUNTY, SR 423: The grading, drainage, construction of a concrete I-beam bridge on SR 423 over Clear Creek. Motorists should watch for trucks entering and exiting the roadway.

DYER COUNTY, SR-20: Repair of bridges over North Fork Forked Deer River.

Restrictions: Traffic is reduced to one lane in each direction with a **12'** lane restriction.

*Speed limit has been reduced to **55 MPH**.

HENRY COUNTY, SR-54: The grading, drainage, construction of bridges, retaining wall and paving on SR 54 from near Rison Street to near Smith Road. Motorists should watch for trucks entering and exiting the roadway.

LAKE COUNTY, SR-78: Construction of a concrete Bulb-Tee bridge on SR 78 over drainage ditch including grading, drainage, and paving will cause possible lane closures throughout the project.

Restrictions: **Beginning Tuesday, August 1 through November 30, 2018**, a traffic signal system is being utilized. Traffic is reduced to one lane in each direction with a **9'** lane restriction.

OBION COUNTY, Future I-69: Grading, drainage, construction of eight bridges on future I-69 from south of US 51 (SR 3) to south of US 45W (SR 5) will cause possible lane closures throughout the project. *Speed limit is reduced to **45 MPH** through the US 51 (SR 3) portion of the project. The inside southbound lane on SR 3 is closed to all traffic for installation of barrier rail.

Restrictions: **Tuesday, June 13**, SR 3 has a lane shift in the north and southbound directions. Traffic is reduced to one lane in each direction with a **11' 6"** lane restriction.

OBION COUNTY, SR-5: Installation of signals on US-45W (SR 5) at the intersection of Jackson Street in Union City.

District 48 - West TN – Middle/Southern

CROCKETT COUNTY, SR 76: The grading, drainage, paving and construction of bridges on SR 76 over Cypress Creek and overflow. Beginning February 7, 2018, temporary signals will be utilized.

Restriction: There will be a 12' width restriction in place.



DECATUR COUNTY, SR 69: Beginning February 7, 2018 there will be a lane closure on SR 69 (LM 36.56) to repair the bridge over Lick Creek. Temporary signals will be in use.

Restriction: There will be a 12' width restriction in place.

FAYETTE COUNTY, I-40: The grading, drainage, construction of a concrete bulb-tee bridge and paving on I-40 at the SR 196 (Hickory Withe Road) interchange. Motorists should watch for trucks entering and exiting the roadway.

Wednesday, January 31, through Wednesday, February 7: There are no scheduled closures.

HARDIN COUNTY, SR-128: A widening project on SR 128 from South of Opel Loop to US-64 (SR 15) in Savannah will cause possible lane closures throughout the project. Motorists should watch for trucks entering and exiting the roadway from the construction zones and also crossing the roadways.

HARDIN COUNTY, SR-128: The grading, drainage, and paving on SR 128 from south of One Stop Drive to south of Opel Loop. Motorists should watch for trucks entering and exiting the roadway from the construction zones and also crossing the roadways

HARDEMAN COUNTY, SR-100: A bridge repair on SR-100 over branch at LM 4.34 will cause the roadway to be reduced to one lane with a temporary traffic signal.

HAYWOOD COUNTY-SR-19 (Brownsville Bypass): A widening project on SR 19 from west of Windrow Road to SR 76 south of Brownsville will cause possible lane closures throughout the project. Motorists should watch for trucks entering and exiting the roadway from the construction zones and also crossing the roadways.

HAYWOOD COUNTY-SR-76: Construction of a concrete bulb tee beam bridge over the Hatchie River – **Wednesday, May 3, 2017 SR 76 CLOSED approx. 1 mile south of the I-40/Exit 56 interchange for removal of the truss bridge.**

*Local traffic will have access up to the bridge. An interstate detour will be posted at Exit 56 and Exit 52 (Stanton/KoKo Road).

MADISON COUNTY, SR-186 (US45 Bypass) and I-40: Interchange improvements on SR-186 (US 45) north and southbound from the I-40 ramps (LM 2.83) to Old Hickory Blvd (LM 3.33) for paving and construction of retaining walls. Widening of I-40 from just east of Exit 79 to just east of Exit 82.

Friday, February 2, 8:00 a. m.-5:00 p. m.: There will be rolling road blocks on I-40 east and westbound, including both right and left lanes, from MM 79-82 for repair of potholes.

Backup date: Monday February 5 8:00 a. m.-5:00 p. m.

TDOT REGION 4: On-Call Pavement Markings:

Wednesday, January 31, through Wednesday, February 7: There are no scheduled closures.

TDOT REGION 4: On-Call Guardrail Repair/Concrete Barrier Rail Repair:

Monday, February 5, through Thursday, February 8, 8:00 p. m.-6:00 a. m.: There will be night time lane closures at the following various locations to repair damaged guardrail. THP will assist with traffic control. **Weather Permitting.**

- I-40, Haywood, Henderson, and Decatur Counties, east and westbound MM 67-126.12

TDOT MAINTENANCE:

Wednesday, January 31, through Wednesday, February 7, 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p. m.: There will be possible lane closures at various locations in Region IV in order to patch potholes on an as needed basis.



Wednesday, January 31, 9:00 a.m.-3:30 p. m.: There will be lane closures on I-40 in Henderson and Decatur Counties from MM 95-126 both east and westbound to repair potholes.

Friday, February 2, 9:00 a.m.-3:30 p. m.: There will be lane closures on I-40 in Haywood County from mile marker 45-67 both east and westbound to repair potholes.

District 49 - West TN - Southwest

FAYETTE COUNTY, I-40: The grading, drainage, construction of a concrete bulb-tee bridge and paving on I-40 at the SR 196 (Hickory Withe Road) interchange. Motorists should watch for trucks entering and exiting the roadway. Speed limit has been reduced to **60 MPH**.

FAYETTE COUNTY – I-40 Pothole Repair:

Thursday, February 1, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.: **INTERMITTENT** lane closures on I-40 westbound (inside and outside) lanes beginning at MM 32.00 (close to SR 59) through MM 42.00 (Fayette/Haywood Co. Line.) to allow for pothole repair. **Weather Permitting.** * Friday, February 2, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. will serve as a backup date.

FAYETTE COUNTY – I-40 over the Loosahatchie River

Thursday, February 2, 10:00 a. m.-1:00 p. m.: There will be a temporary lane closure on I-40 eastbound over the Loosahatchie River for a chain drag.

FAYETTE COUNTY, US 70 (US 79, SR-1): A bridge repair project on SR 1 over branch will result in lane closures in both directions daily.

FAYETTE COUNTY- SR-59 over I-40: A bridge repair project on US-70 (SR 79, SR 1) over branch and on SR 59 over I-40.

SHELBY COUNTY, I-40 at Exit 1 to Exit 1A: Bridge repair project will cause possible lane closures on I-40 over the Mississippi River and 5 bridges over Wolf River, various ramps and city streets and railroad.

Friday, February 2, 7:00 p.m. through Monday, February 5, 5:00 a.m.: Riverside Drive northbound ramp access to I-40 east and westbound will be **CLOSED** at Jefferson Avenue to replace the joints (This ramp carries traffic from Riverside Drive northbound to I-40 westbound into Arkansas). Detour routes will be along Front Street for Arkansas westbound traffic and Third Street for Tennessee eastbound traffic. **Weather Permitting.**

SHELBY COUNTY – I-40 and I-55 Pothole Repair:

Thursday, February 1, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.: **INTERMITTENT** lane closures on **I-40 east and westbound** outside lane beginning at MM 2.00 (Chelsea Rd.) through MM 5.00 (Hollywood Str.) to allow for pothole repair. **Weather Permitting.** * Friday, February 2, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. will serve as a backup date.

Thursday, February 1, and Friday, February 2, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.: **INTERMITTENT** lane closures on **I-40 east and westbound** outside lane beginning at MM 18.00 (Exit – Hwy 64) through MM 25.00 (Airline Rd.) to allow for pothole repair. **Weather Permitting.** * Monday, February 5, and Tuesday, February 6, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. will serve as a backup date.

Thursday, February 1, and Friday, February 2, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.: **INTERMITTENT** lane closures on **I-55 north and southbound** outside lane beginning at MM 0.00 (State Line Rd.) through



MM 2.40 (Goodhaven Rd.) to allow for pothole repair. **Weather Permitting.** * Monday, February 5, and Tuesday, February 6, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. will serve as a backup date.

SHELBY COUNTY, I-240 MemFix 4: Replacement of Norfolk Southern, SR 57 east and westbound bridges, and repair of Park Avenue bridge over I-240.

I-240: There are shoulder closures in both directions of I-240 NB/SB between Quince and Walnut Grove.

The lane closures along **I-240** east and westbound between Quince and Walnut Grove will stay in place throughout the project.

SHELBY COUNTY, Eastmoreland over I-240 (L.M. 036) and on U.S. 51 (S.R. 3) over the Wolf River (L.M. 15.25): Bridge repair will cause possible lane closures throughout the project.

SHELBY COUNTY, SR-1: Construction of a welded steel plate girder bridge on SR 1 over the Loosahatchie River will cause possible lane closures throughout the project.

SHELBY COUNTY, SR-14 (Austin Peay Hwy): Construction on SR 14 for a widening project from SR 204 (Singleton Parkway) to east of Old Covington Pike. Shoulders are closed north and southbound. There will be possible temporary lane closures throughout the project.

On April 21, 2017, Old Covington Pike East access to/from SR 14 was permanently **CLOSED**.

*Speed limit has been reduced to **45 MPH**.

SHELBY COUNTY, SR-14: The grading, drainage, construction of concrete Bulb-Tee and I-beam bridges, signals and paving on SR 14 from east of Old Covington Pike (L.M. 26.15) to SR 385 (L.M. 29.82) will cause possible lane closures throughout the project.

SHELBY COUNTY, SR-175—Resurfacing on SR 175 from near Elvis Presley Blvd. to Swinnea.

TIPTON COUNTY, SR-3 (HWY 51) DRAIN CLEANING:

Tuesday, February 6 through Thursday 8 , 9AM-2PM: CLOSE the inside lane on SR-3 (HWY 51) northbound beginning at MM 10.50 (at BCI Curve near Old 51) through MM 12.00 (near Melrose Rd.) to allow for cross drain cleaning. **Weather Permitting.**

TIPTON COUNTY, SR-3 (HWY 51) POTHOLE REPAIR:

Thursday, February 1, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.: **INTERMITTENT** lane closures on SR-3 (HWY 51) both directions (outside and inside) lane beginning at MM 16.00 (close to Holly Grove Rd.) through MM 19.00 (close to South Hall Rd.) to allow for pothole repair. **Weather Permitting.** * Friday, February 2, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. will serve as a backup date.

SHELBY and FAYETTE COUNTY, - SR 385 Sign Conversion for I-269

Wednesday, January 31 and Thursday, February 01, 8:00 p.m.–6:00 a.m.: There will be night time closures at the following various locations to allow drilling for soil samples for the proposed overhead sign structures. If weather prohibits, the repairs will be performed on the next available night. THP will assist with traffic control during night time closures. **Weather Permitting.**

Wednesday, January 31 and Thursday, February 01, 8:00 p.m.–6:00 a.m.: (Back up day for Monday, January 29 and Tuesday, January 30)

- I-269 northbound (SR 385), MM 31.2 – 31.4; One lane will be **CLOSED**.
- I-40 eastbound, MM 22.6 – MM 22.8; One lane will be **CLOSED**.
- I-40 westbound, MM 27.0 – MM 26.8; One lane will be **CLOSED**.
- I-269 southbound (SR 385), MM 33.6 – MM 33.4; One lane will be **CLOSED**.

LOOK AHEAD:

Monday, February 12 and Tuesday, February 13, 8:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m.: There will be night time ramp closures at the following I-40/ I-269 interchange to update guardrail and install delineators. If weather prohibits, the repairs will be performed on the next available night. THP will assist with traffic control during night time closures. **Weather Permitting.**

Monday, February 12, 8:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m.:

- I-40 eastbound to I-269 northbound, ramp will be **CLOSED.**
- I-269 northbound to I-40 westbound, ramp will be **CLOSED.**

TDOT MAINTENANCE:

Wednesday, January 31, through Wednesday, February 7, 9:00 a. m.-3:00 p. m.: There will be possible lane closures at various locations in Region IV in order to repair pavement on an as needed basis.

TDOT District 49 On-Call Guardrail/Concrete Barrier Rail Repair:

Wednesday, January 31, through Tuesday, February 06, 8:00 p. m.-6:00 a. m.: There will be night time lane closures at the following various locations to repair damaged guardrail. If weather prohibits, the repairs will be performed on the next available night. THP will assist with traffic control during night time closures. **Weather Permitting.**

- I-40 east and westbound, MM 2.8 – MM 9.5, various locations; One lane will be **CLOSED.**
- I-240 east and westbound, MM 21.0 – MM 30.2, various locations; One lane will be **CLOSED.**
- I-240 westbound EXIT 25A to I-55 southbound will be **CLOSED.**
- I-240 eastbound "On" ramp from Madison Avenue, MM 30.2; One lane will be **CLOSED.**
- I-55 northbound, MM 4.2; One lane will be **CLOSED.**
